



The “Barrel Theory”

Yield is limited by the nutrient in shortest supply.

Many growers cut back on secondary micronutrients if they feel they need to save money. They think those minute traces will not affect yield “all that much.” With the help of a wooden barrel we can see how that cut back in nutrients may affect the entire yield. N, P and K may be applied to support a 175 bushel corn crop, but if there is only enough zinc to grow 150 bushel of corn per acre your maximum yield will be 150 bushels. Without the needed micronutrients, a crop cannot reach its full potential. Another way to express this theory is the fact that a chain is only as strong as its weakest link. Make Nulex Liquid Zinc one of the strongest links in your micronutrient chain.
